- 3. Er. Lokesh Hebbani and Dr. S Raghunath advised to appoint one external member from industry and one from academics to Academic Advisory Committee. Also suggested to use electronic mode of communication, if required.
- 4. Dr. S Raghunath advised to change title of first year course from Elements of Civil Engineering to Engineering Mechanics and syllabus accordingly. However other members opined to retain the course title as Elements of Civil Engineering and Mechanics, as some of the units were focused on Civil Engineering concepts.
- 5. Members collectively opined not to make group of electives instead option may be given to choose required elective course from basket of elective courses from 5th to 8th semester.
- 6. Scheme of evaluation of Extensive Survey Camp 16CV74 and Technical Tour & Seminar in VIII Semester was discussed and approved by the members.
- 7. Draft 2018 scheme of M Tech Structural Engineering and M Tech Highway Technology was approved by members. Few electives were introduced in each semester. During First semester- 2 Electives (Elective A and Elective B were offered with 3 courses each in Elective A and Elective B respectively) and during Second Semester 2 Electives (Elective C and Elective D were offered with 3 courses each in Elective A and Elective B respectively)
- 8. However following suggestions were made.
 - To offer pool of electives, instead of grouping them
 - Not to restrict the number of students to be 50% to offer electives
- 9. Chairperson briefed minutes of Academic Advisory Committee held until June 2018, Budget allocation of 2018-19 and utilization of 2017-18.
- 10. Chairperson Dr. M V RenukaDevi appraised the changes to be incorporated based on the feedbacks received from Alumni, Industry, Faculty and students such as courses in emerging technology, Innovative teaching methods adopted, ICT tools and Software training.
- 11. Meeting was concluded by the chairperson thanking all the members present.



- . 2. Dr. K S Lokesh suggested to offer electives even for minimum five students.
 - 3. Dr. Ravindra R, explained VTU and AICTE Schemes for Post Graduate Program to all BoS members.
 - 4. Members appreciated the inclusion of a course on "Green building systems and embodied energy" as a Global elective.

- 5. Dr. K. S. Lokesh and Dr. Shivakumara Swamy insisted to conduct SEE for the audit course so that it would be taken up more intensively by PG students. However it was suggested to shift the audit course to third semester.
- 6. Dr. K. S. Lokesh and Dr. S. V. Dinesh recommended to allocate maximum of four credits for all the courses. At present four courses are with five credits in 2018 PG Autonomous scheme.
- 7. Dr. K S Lokesh suggested to include seminars in all semesters.
- 8. All BoS members strongly suggested to reduce the number of contact hours and to emphasis more on research, hands on training and field exposure, which is very essential for any PG Program.
- 9. Dr. Amarnath and Dr. S. V. Dinesh suggested to include Research methodology as an mandatory course in first semester which will aid in inculcating paper writing and literature review skills
- 10. Members of BoS suggested to reduce theory courses and give more emphasis on internship and dissertation work during second year.
- 11. Dr. Amarnath suggested to include Highway construction and maintenance as a core course in second semester, as a part M Tech Highway Technology 2018 scheme. Advanced traffic engineering has been included as an elective.
- 12. Members of BoS suggested to have applications towards area of specialization in mathematics course and the same was recommended to be handled by program specific faculty.
- 13. The draft Program outcomes for 2018 scheme of both the programs were discussed.
- 14. The course learning objectives, Course contents and course outcomes of all the courses of M Tech Structural Engineering and Highway Technology were reviewed and suggested for modifications where ever required. Feedback from alumni, Students, Faculty and industry, IQAC were discussed and incorporated.
- 15. Minutes of Equivalence committee were discussed and finalized



Dr. Radhakrishna, Chairman greeted all BoS members. The minutes of 22nd BoS meeting and action taken were read and recorded. BoS chairman briefed the following

- 1. The agenda and about the recent development at RVCE particularly at Department of Civil Engineering
- 2. The reduction in credits from 200 (2016 scheme) to 175 (2018 scheme) as per AICTE guidelines.
- 3. Inclusion of design thinking lab, internship, online courses in 2018 scheme and highlighted provision for BE honours degree by earning 20 credits extra through online certification courses (spread across III to VII sem).

- 3- Dr. H N Ramesh seeked clarification about the process of evaluation for CIE and SEE and the same was clarified by BoS Chairman
- 5. Er. Nagendra Kumar suggested that, the assessment of assignment including suggestion of topic and evaluation should be time bound.
- 6. Dr. H N Ramesh insisted to conduct only two CIE and one compensatory test as CIE III.
- 7. Dr. H N Ramesh highlighted the high work load on the teachers for non-technical activities and he insisted upon giving more time for R&D to teachers
- 8. Dr. H N Ramesh and Dr.Jayanthi suggested to include research component for assignment as an alternative assessment tool.
- 9. Er.Nagendra Kumar suggested to incorporate professional ethics as mandatory course in curriculum.
- 10.Dr. Jayanthi insisted to introduce Carbon Footprint as an open elective.
- 11. Er.Nagendra Kumar suggested making arrangements to exhibit engineering materials to have a feel by students as part of curriculum
- 12. Er: Nagendra Prasad suggested that the physical soil samples of all classes of soil should be shown to students
