




Principal, Dr.K.N Subramanya also welcomes the alumni gathered and shared insights on improvement work happening at RVCE.

After the function, different games and networking was done between the alumni and staff. The lunch for the event was sponsored by Alumni Association.



He started teaching on the roadside footpath of National College, Jayanagar to random students who found difficulty in trigonometry. Over a period of 13 years he has taught 3000+ students.

Rohit's hunger of becoming an Engineer didn't get buried in-spite of his poverty. After clearing 12th class in RV PU College, he got into R V College of Engineering, in 2008. At RVCE he bagged the world's most prestigious scholarship award, a whooping amount of 6 lakhs Rupees from ABB which covered the complete expense of engineering college fees and stood out to be one amongst the first three Indian students. Two years later, in 2010, ABB a leading Electrical and Automation company in the world organized an "International Young Engineers" meet held in Zurich, Switzerland in which Rohith andteam represented his college and INDIA on an international platform. There he presented a unique idea of "Generation of Electricity using Renewable Resources". He won this prestigious competition that had 150 participants from 30 different countries.

When Rohit was in the penultimate year of engineering, he landed 3 job offers from MNCs such as Cognizant, ABB and Nestle. He joined Nestle, which is the world's no 1 FMCG Company in July 2012 and worked with them for half an year at Haryana, eventually he joined ABB as a Process Development Specialist and worked there for 4 years

With an intention to push the young people of our country to set big goals and go after it, he initiated a project called CYD, which stands for "Chase Your Dreams". As a part of the project, he has inspired 50000+ students over a period of 3 years by visiting 150 different educational institutions across INDIA. Very recently the same work was identified and appreciated by YOGA UNIVERSITY OF THE AMERICAS felicitated the prestigious national level "Bharatiya samskruthi Bhushana" award. 


