- iii) Provide healthy and secure atmosphere for all women at all the places and facilities on the campus.
- iv) Facilitate registration of grievances related to women and sexual harassment on UGC Student Grievance Redressal Portal.
- v) Prominently display and inform Toll free number : 1800-111-656 to all concerned for registration of grievances related to women and sexual harassment.

A detailed presentation & document regarding the POSH Act 2013 has been attached which must be used during the program and the same has to be mandatorily circulated with your employees after the completion of the program thereby providing a safe workplace for women.

Note: The report on the legal awareness program must include video/photo/minutes of meeting and all documents related to constitution of ICC in your organisation.
